2016 CHARDONNAY, ANDERSON VINEYARD The nose is a beautifully nuanced toffee, lemon and yellow apple. The palate entry is polished lemon and mineral with a ripe core of pear and white peach with focused citrus on the finish. Drink 2017 – 2024. **2015 PINOT NOIR, FAMIGLIA** The nose is a dusty red berry with underlying graphite and florals. The palate is gorgeously supple on entry with solid, silky and well-poised acidity in the core helps make it so attractive and approachable. Drink 2017 – 2028. **2015 PINOT NOIR, LA SORELLA** A silky nose with hard cherry, licorice and herb. The palate offers a gorgeous entry of polished black cherry braced by deep essence of spicy blackberry. Excellent length. Drink 2017 – 2026. **2015 PINOT NOIR, LACHINI VINEYARD** The nose offers nicely layered violet and herb leading to a massively lush palate entry with polished black cherry and a firm tannic backbone. Drink 2019 – 2030. **2015 PINOT NOIR, ONELIA** The nose is elegantly layered cherry, cassis and graphite. The palate entry is full-bodied ripeness with a core of bright red fruit and graphite and balanced acidity. Drink 2017 – 2026.
